After School Program Contract and Consent

Welcome to our **Kid Street After School Program**! The After School Program (ASP) provides a safe, fun and nurturing environment for our students immediately after school dismissal until 6:00 PM every school day. ASP is a Kid Street run program. **Participation should be considered a privilege.**

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Behavior Expectations: Following directions from any adult in charge, show respect for other students and adults in language and actions, respect of school and after school property, being in supervised areas. All Kid Street Charter School policies in the student handbook apply to ASP.

ASP rules and suspension from our program are NON-NEGOTIABLE. Students who are suspended more than three (3) times will result in termination of our after school program for the remainder of the academic school year. Misconduct/inappropriate behavior includes stealing, intentional damages of property, physical assault on any student/staff, excessive profanity/obscene language and open defiance of any adult in charge. **Behavior expectations that are broken will result in the following:**

- (1) 1st offense is a 3 day suspension
- (2) 2nd offense is a 1 week suspension,
- (3) the 3rd offense is a 2 week suspension.

Prior to returning after the 3rd suspension, a meeting must be held with the parent/guardian, student and the After School Program Director to discuss behavior expectations. **Physical assault on any adult in charge is immediate dismissal from the program for the remainder of the year.**

Defiance has been an ongoing issue that staff has been struggling with throughout the years. Defiance is defined as a student's intentional refusal to obey rules, directives, expectations, or to challenge authority. Examples of defiance include refusing to follow directions, challenging the adult in charge, disrupting the program, being non-compliant and engaging in conflict. Any student who is defiant will be suspended immediately.

Late Pick Ups

Our After School Program ends at 6PM. A **late pickup fee of \$1 per minute, per student** will be charged for pickups occurring after 6:00 PM. Families with **more than three late pickups** may be subject to termination of enrollment in the After School Program

Homework Club Expectations

All students are expected to participate in our Homework Club, complete their assigned work, and follow staff directions.

Students must maintain a quiet and respectful environment so that everyone has an opportunity to work. If a student is disrupting others, refusing to do their work, or unable to work appropriately in a quiet environment, they may be asked to leave Homework Club and work independently in a supervised area.

If the behavior continues, a meeting with the parent/guardian and Program Director will be required. Continued behavioral issues may result in the student being terminated from the After School Program.
